### The EXAM

The exam consists of 200 multiple choice questions that test your knowledge in the areas of:

- Case Management
- Utilization Management
- Quality Improvement & Management
- Disease Management
- Managed Care Models, Contracting, Products, & Reimbursement
- Government Programs
- Patient Issues

The exam is administered by an eligible proctor within a 4-hour testing window. The exam fee is \$250.

#### **Certification Renewal**

To keep your certification current, you must submit 25 contact hours of approved continuing education and \$55 every 3 years. Nursing CEs, academic courses, self study courses, conference attendance, and workshops may be considered for certification renewal.

## Who is eligible to test?

Those with a current, active and unrestricted licensure or certification in healthcare - RNs, LPN/LVNs, LCSWs, LMSWs, LPCs and others may pursue eligibility.

To gain eligibility, candidates must pursue **one** of the following processes:

1. Submit a signed job description, resume and educational background that attests to their knowledge of managed care overview, healthcare economics, healthcare management, & patient issues. Approval reviews are performed on a quarterly basis by the ABMCN Board of Directors.

2. Candidates can complete the Home Study course provided by the American Association of Managed Care Nurses (AAMCN).
